This part-time position will work 20 hours each week, Tuesday through Friday, from noon to 5:00 pm. The potential to pick up more hours and to grow in this role will be possibilities for the right person.

Shift locations will vary between our two Portland Ronald McDonald House locations, with two to three shifts each week at our South Waterfront location, near the base of the OHSU Tram. The pay rate for this position starts at \$15-\$16 an hour.

The Operations Assistant is a key member of Operations Team, and will be focused on facility maintenance and repairs, troubleshooting guest and staff technology, and supplies and inventory logistics. Additionally, the Operations Assistant will be a key point of contact for our housekeeping, laundry, and facility contractor and vendor partners. Our Operations Team brings a wide range of skills to the everyday work of supporting the families we serve and our staff and volunteer teams across our two Portland locations. We are looking to add the right person to grow with us and help us take this to the next level.

The right fit for this position will have experience and be eager to learn more about facility maintenance, repairs, and building systems. Additionally, experience with technology including computers and mobile devices and networks, and an interest in tackling a wide range of tasks that go into making our guest families comfortable is key. If we put some tools in front of you, you should know what they are, how to use them, and be excited to figure it out. You must have a valid driver's license.
