Ronald McDonald House Charities Hosts Annual Golf Classic

Golfers tee off at Pumpkin Ridge in support of families with seriously ill children

PORTLAND, OR — On Monday, July 17, Ronald McDonald House Charities of Oregon & Southwest Washington (RMHC) will host its 15th Annual Golf Classic. Held at Pumpkin Ridge Golf Club in North Plains, the day-long tournament will raise money to support families with seriously ill children staying at no charge at Oregon's three Ronald McDonald Houses.

Since 2002, the Golf Classic has been an essential part of RMHC's fundraising program. "Every year, this event is more fun and exciting," says CEO Jessica Jarratt Miller. "We love seeing our sponsors and donors come together to support a wonderful cause and enjoy the gorgeous courses at Pumpkin Ridge. The money we raise goes a long way towards fulfilling our vision: providing compassionate hospitality for the 56 families we serve every night."

The host of six national championships, Pumpkin Ridge has presented the RMHC Golf Classic for each of its fifteen years. Nearly 300 golfers will play the par-71, 6,839-yard Ghost Creek and par-72, 7,017-yard private Witch Hollow courses. In 2016, the event drew more than 280 participants and raised more than \$250,000 — funds that helped directly support 1,825 families that stayed for a total of 17,917 nights.
